The Northwest Region did not elect officers for this year and were put in suspension by the NBOD at the post board. The National Board of Directors has voted to rescind that suspension and has appointed PNP Gail Doloway as the Administrator for the Northwest Region. Sam Rose Memorial Scholarship: awarded to the male or female candidate chosen from the sons, daughters, grandsons, or granddaughters of deceased LA FRA and FRA members by the National President and her committee.

Allie Mae Oden Memorial Scholarship: awarded to the candidate chosen from the children or grandchildren of members of the LA FRA or FRA by the National President and her committee in the name of the LA FRA.

National President's Scholarship: awarded annually to the candidate chosen from children and grandchildren of members of the LA FRA or FRA or deceased members of the LA FRA or the FRA by the National President and the committee. # Did you know?

This month we are planning to discuss who, what and where when it comes to the monies for the LA FRA.

Membership Services Administrator (MSA): Membership dues whether they are for new, renewal and/or reinstate should be sent to the MSA. Checks should be made out to LA FRA. Do not send cash! Remember the MSA deals only with monies dealing with member's dues!

<u>National Financial Secretary (NFS):</u> All other monies, for whatever reason, must be sent to the NFS for accounting purposes. Checks should be made out to <u>LA FRA</u> and in the memo line it should designate where you wish to have the monies to go to. Any monies received with no designation will go into the General Fund. Please do not send cash!

Things that you might want to contribute to are; LA FRA Scholarship Fund, Sam Rose Memorial Scholarship Fund, Allie Mae Oden Memorial Scholarship Fund, NP Scholarship Fund, Welfare and Rehabilitation Fund and of course the NP Project. .

In accordance with C&BL's, all Units are requested to send \$5.00 each year to the Pilgrimage Fund. This is to pay for wreaths and other Pilgrimage expenses. This is usually sent to the NFS sometime in February.

Whenever you need any resale items, remember to order them in a timely manner. Do not wait until the last minute. Please give the NFS sufficient time to receive, gather the order and get it out. Keep in mind that from time to time items may be out of stock and on order from our distributor. Also make sure the check is made out to **LA FRA** and is for the correct amount. If it isn't for the correct amount, it may delay you getting your item(s) in a timely manner.

Thank you for your confidence in electing me, the National Vice President 2017-2018. I consider it an honor and a privilege to continue to serve you. One might think that the Vice-Presidential year is a little lax after serving as the NFS, however, I view it as the biggest challenge of my life maintaining and hopefully increasing the membership. On April 1<sup>st</sup>, 2017 the LA FRA had 6,383 members. The October reports indicate 6,213 members, a loss of 170 members. We have many Units who are maintaining their membership numbers, congratulations and thank you. There are four Units who are leading the way in membership gains. Bravo Zulu Units 24, 70, 91 and 170.



Keeping the meetings positive, doing charitable work, and providing positive social interactions are all ways to maintain membership and encourage new members. LA FRA members can make a difference one person at a time. By publicizing your community involvement and being seen representing the organization. Ask Unit 93 about the "Out of the Darkness Walk", Unit 24 about the "Vet Dogs annual event or monthly membership information sessions, or Unit 163 about the impact of yearly parade participation. There are many other Units who are actively involved in the community, share your story and let others know about your events.

The National Vice President Project for 2017-2018 is "Honoring our Heritage and Forging the Future". Twenty years ago, during PNP Barbara Sherwood's Vice-Presidential year she asked the members to Crow about the LA FRA. Today, I am asking you to Crow about the Auxiliary and reach those eligible for membership or reinstate those who let their membership lapse. The first 165 members to recruit 3 new members or reinstate 3 members will receive a beautiful Gold Rooster pin. Remember according to SR 4(g) if someone recruits 10 new members they should receive a Gold pin and for 25 additional members a Silver Star guard. A Silver Anchor pin is awarded when the member recruits 50 members and for each additional 25 members they should receive a corresponding Silver Star. Let's all Crow, the Future of this Auxiliary depends on each of us.
