C & BL - PAGE 41 – ARTICLE 8, SECTION 809(q) 7(d) - States: Annually report to the NP and NVP a list of the Life Membership until such time as all life members are verified as deceased or unable to locate. Upon removal from the Life Member List the members name shall be included in the next National LA FRA Memorial Ceremony.

Edited the underlined words from Member to Membership

Edited the underlined words to National Convention Memorial Service

C & BL – Page 37 – Article 8, SECTION 808(n) “states in the third line “including the reporter’s original copy,” and as we will now longer be using the recorder that the word be removed. The line will therefore read published minutes, including the reporter’s original copy, be change to state; published minutes, including the original copy.

C & BL - Page 37 – Article 8, SECTION 808(p) “states The current original recorder’s transcript of the convention minutes. Again as we will not be having a recorder’s transcript change to state; The current original transcript of the convention minutes. Editing out the word “recorder’s”

C & BL – Page 38 – Article 809, Section 809(c) This whole Section needs to be deleted and have (d) become (c) and so forth. National President, Parliamentarian and C & BL Chairman to decide on a resolution or not.

STANDING RULES

SR - 8(b) Page 11 Remove last line – Funds for the flowers shall be forwarded to the LA FRA, Unit 46 to be deleted as Unit 46 no longer exists.

SR - 10(n) Page 15 Change from Minutes to Convention Minutes

SR - 10(o) Page 16 Change from Minutes to Distribution of Minutes

SR - 16(d) Page 24 Change from Safety Deposit Box to kept in the safe at the FRA National Headquarters

SR – 22(d) Page 32 States: Article for The TRIANGLE shall reach the National President on or before the 5<sup>th</sup> day of the month for approval. All approved items for publication shall then be forwarded to the National Executive Secretary who reproduces them and mails them by the 26<sup>th</sup> day of each month, except the bulletin affected by the National Convention shall be mailed the discretion of the National Executive Secretary.

Change the underlined portion to: to be distributed on or about the 26<sup>th</sup> of month, except the bulletin affected by the National convention shall be distributed at the discretion of the NES

ADDED; Top of page 33 – Due to stating being mailed change the word mail to distributed. “The Triangle” it should state to be distributed on or about the 26<sup>th</sup> of the month.

SR – 30(a) & (b) Page 44 At the bottom of each section it states: “uniform cover with the LA FR emblem and Unit number.” As we don’t have the emblem on our hats as the men do, this need to be removed as we have not had this on LA FRA hats and has not been done in over 50 years the word emblem for these sections.

SR – 31(a) (1) Page 45 The SR was amended to read as follows: Uniform cap worn by members of the Auxiliary shall be as follows: (1) For female member; A silk lined overseas type Cap of Navy Blue and Gold, with crown to be ad of gold twill, or other suitable material, the apron to be of Navy Blue woolen cloth, or other suitable material. The Unit number shall be in material, front, and, if desired, the Unit geographic location and the highest office held, with years served, shall be on the left side, embroidered in gold. In addition, the name, Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association may be embroidered in gold, on the right side. Grandfathering all prior hats bearing the name Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association. All prior hats bearing the name Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association are grandfathered, thus requiring no one is change their current hat and any member who feels so strongly that any new hat the may buy also state Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association may do so.

Due to the fact that grandfathered was used twice the first one was deleted. This has been underlined above. Also feels so strongly that any new hat has been changed to read “Any member that wishes to purchase a new hat that it can also state Ladies Auxiliary Fleet Reserve Association it they so desire”

SR – 31(a) (2) page 45 As SR 31(a)(1) and SR 32(a)(5) have the word Ladies having wished to be removed therefore on the men’s style hat the hat reads “The Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association” and this was omitted in error to have it changed as well, therefore, the men’s hat shall state “ Auxiliary Fleet Reserve Association”


What year served? ..... 2021-2022

It was an honor to meet Brian Thacker former US Army officer and a recipient of the US military highest decoration for Valor, the Metal of Honor for his actions in Vietnam. Pearl Harbor 80<sup>th</sup> Remembrance Services at Wesley Bolin Memorial Plaza, Phoenix, AZ. It was an honor to attend this as the National President and represent the Auxiliary. Branch 163 Shipmates Bryan Ginter, Joe Bland, and Unit 163 Carlene Baldosser. Thank you to PNP Bea Parco for her hard job taking beautiful pictures and being a tour guide of Phoenix.

National President Jim Campbell and National President Pat Suckow had the honor of placing the wreath. This day dedicated to the men and women serving at Pearl Harbor on the fateful day as well as those who followed to bring about a victorious end to World War II.

Special Guest US Air Force Maj Fannie Griffin McClendon who was part of the famed "Six Triple Eight Central Postal Directory Battalion and Erlinda Gallegos Avila an original Rosie the Riveter. She served with the United States Navy Waves. She was a member of the Jewish War Veterans. They were both flown in by helicopter. There was a commemorative flyover performed by members of the Stearman Group led by Captain Fred Gorrell with their World War II biplanes. This day will live forever in her heart.

She also visited the USS Arizona Memorial Gardens at Salt River. This area honors the brave US forces who were aboard the USS Arizona during the attack on Pearl Harbor. It was a place to reflect and pay respects. It also includes a piece of the original boathouse from the USS Arizona. It was a place to learn more about December 7, 1941. The garden was lilt along the pathways and over water features, ensuring that the legacy of those aboard the USS Arizona will forever live on. The gardens opened in February 2020.

She had the opportunity of visiting the Hyatt Hotel where the National Convention for 2022 will be held and thought it was a beautiful hotel and for the shoppers there is a two-story mall attached to the hotel.

THE ANNUAL PILGRIMAGE at Arlington National Cemetery held on April 23<sup>rd</sup>, which is an auxiliary tradition and proves to be an immensely powerful and memorable experience. The first Pilgrimage was in 1933. FRA PNP laid the wreath, sent to him by the LA FRA, at the tomb of the Unknown Soldier. This event of visitation was started in 1933-34 by LA FRA National President Catherine Wertman's Americanism Committee. Auxiliary members, Shipmates, and guests enjoyed a beautiful day and had an exceptionally good representation. I was honored at the National President's Tea. The "Tea" beautifully presented by Pilgrimage Chairman Doreen Huylebroeck PNP and Debra Washington PRPEC. Was honored to participate in the LA FRA Historical Pilgrimage, to give the eulogy and it is breathtaking to stand at the top of the stairs at "The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier," overlooking this grave and others throughout the cemetery, and absorb the reverence paid to these honored veterans. She was escorted to the Tomb of the Unknown by FRA NP James Campbell FRA and PNP Michael "Mick" Fulton, to present LA FRA Memorial Wreath.

There were 30 applications received and 10 were incomplete: Lacking an essay, transcripts or letters of recommendations. Of the 20 remaining they represented the North East/ New England Area, East Coast, South East, South Central, West Coast and North Central Regions. To be fair to all applicants they were graded using a point system grid with the essay being weighted of up to 20 points. Points were deducted for eligible applications, lack of answering all questions, not having the appropriate signatures, not using the current forms and a failure to answer the essay question. The committee suggests that in the future The FRA membership number line includes the Branch or Unit Number. This would reduce the amount of time needed to verify the FRA/LA FRA member and that the application includes a question if the applicant themselves are a member of the LA FRA. It would be beneficial if the application could be PDF fillable and if the question regarding "colleges applied to" could also include a box to indicate which college or university they plan to attend. If they know at the time of application. Just a reminder to anyone with a potential applicant for 2022-2023 There is no penalty for early submissions. Post mark no later than 15 April 2023. Thank you again for this appointment.

This past year we have added, Regional Pages, which means any member may click on a particular Region and see who the current Regional Officers and Chaplain are, and read Newsletters, view pictures of events hosted by various Units, Regional Mid-Year and Regional Convention information. As I receive this information I add it to that Region's Page. We added a link to the NP Project, so that all members can check and get all the information about the current NP Project, including information about how to make a donation.

The website ([www.la-fra.org](http://www.la-fra.org)) has many links for members to get the information they need. 1. About the LA FRA, 2. The ByLaws, 3. The Triangle, 4. Membership Application, 5. National Convention, 6. LA FRA Scholarship Information, 7. LA FRA Forms, 8. FRA Action Center, 9. Regional News, 10. NP Project, 11. Membership Brochure.

We had some glitches this past year, which seem to happen when Go Daddy does an upgrade. We hope they have been addressed and will not be a problem in the future.

Anyone who has a problem getting on the website should contact me, do not try to fix it on your own, this just causes more issues.

Each year immediately after National Convention the website pages that require new information will be updated. The main forms to update are the "Death Notification Form" (we get a new Chaplain each year), National Delegate Sheet, (new location for the next Convention and change of names at the bottom of the form), Unit Officers Information Sheet (change of names at the bottom of the form. Who What Where Form. (New Officers, Chaplain etc... must be updated. Most of the Basic Report Forms do not change from year to year. The main page (the first one you see) has to be updated with the names of the 2022-2023 National Board of Directors, we only list the names and email addresses. If you need phone numbers and addresses they are on the Triangle and the Who What Where form. A "National Officers and Appointments Roster" is sent out each year to the Unit Secretary & President. For privacy sake we do not put the Roster on the Website. You may request a copy.

I enjoy this job very much and have tried to make it more user friendly over the years. The PDF fillable forms have made it much easier for everyone to use and easier to read. (Remember you must download the forms to your computer before you fill them out, you can not save them on the Website.) We try to make changes as the technology improves. Hard to believe that I became a Regional President 1983-1984 with nothing but a Typewriter. Lot of paper went in the trash due to mistakes to messy to be corrected with correction tape. Only copy machine in the County I lived in was the Library and they did not duplicate. We have come a long way since then. Return addresses and mailing addresses had to be written on each one you mailed. Thankful for the technology we have now.


