The FRA National Board of Directors have proposed, debated and approved the following directive for the National Auxiliary action:

NATIONAL BOARD RESOLUTION NUMBER 28-22: Resolved, That National Board of Directors of the Fleet Reserve Association directs the LAFRA to amend Article 3 Section 301(a) LAFRA C&BL by adding:

- (1) FRA membership eligibility from the Charter of the Organization had to meet the following requirements:
 - 1925 USN, USMC Enlisted Male personnel that were transferred to the Fleet Reserve
 - 1970 Career designated Enlisted USCG and USN, USMC and USCG women personnel
 - 1975 All Active Duty Enlisted Sea Service (USN, USMC, USCG) personnel from 1st day of enlistment
 - 2005 Former Enlisted USN, USMC and USCG personnel not discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge or Dishonorable Discharge
- (2) Sponsorship as it pertains to eligibility in the LAFRA must meet one of the criteria listed in paragraph (1) and the information must be verified to be after the listed dates on the proposed Sponsor's DD214.
