Please share & read this important message from our National Parliamentarian at your meeting. Important to know about Mandated changes in membership<mark>.</mark>

From the Desk of the National Parliamentarian:

At the Convention in Birmingham this past October16-22, the FRA National Board of Directors and subsequently, the delegates voted to make changes to the Auxiliary C&BL, Article 3 Section 301 (a). This is a Mandate which took effect immediately at the close of the Convention (10/22/2022). The letter from the FRA reads:

"The FRA National Board of Directors have proposed, debated, and approved the following directives for the National Auxiliary action:

(1) FRA membership eligibility from the Charter of the Organization had to meet the following requirements:

- 1925 - USN, USMC Enlisted Male personnel that were transferred to the Fleet Reserve

- 1970 – Career designated Enlisted USCG and USN, USMC and USCG women personnel

- 1975 - All Active Duty Enlisted Sea Service (USN, USMC, USCG) personnel from 1st day of enlistment

- 2005 – Former Enlisted USN, USMC and USCG personnel not discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge or Dishonorable Discharge

(2) Sponsorship as it pertains to eligibility in the LA FRA must meet one of the criteria listed in paragraph (1) and the information must be verified to be after the listed dates on the proposed Sponsor's DD214." Therefore, C&BL Article 3 Section 301(a) will now read: Section 301(a). *Membership in the LA FRA shall be limited to spouses, parents, grandparents, sisters, brothers, children, stepchildren, and grandchildren not less than sixteen years of age of members of the FRA and widows, widowers, parents, grandparents, sisters, brothers, children, and grandchildren not less than sixteen years of age of persons who were members at the time of death or eligible to be members of the FRA at the time of death after*

1925 - USN, USMC Enlisted Male personnel that were transferred to the Fleet Reserve

- 1970 – Career designated Enlisted USCG and USN, USMC and USCG women personnel

- 1975 – All Active Duty Enlisted Sea Service (USN, USMC, USCG) personnel from 1st day of enlistment

- 2005 – Former Enlisted USN, USMC and USCG personnel not discharged with a Bad Conduct Discharge or Dishonorable Discharge If the sponsor is still alive, they **MUST** be current members of the FRA. If the sponsor is deceased, the dates above MUST be verified using his/her DD214 (you **CANNOT** keep or copy the DD214).

Applications **MUST** be signed by the person in the Unit responsible signifying that the applicant AND sponsor have been vetted.
