# From the Desk of the National President

What a historical year we are having, we are challenged to find procedures to work around our current predicament in holding meetings due to COVID-19 mandates. The safety and wellbeing for our members is a priority. On June 30, 2020, at the FRA BOD Mid-Year, it has been voted that the 2020 National Convention be postponed for one year. The new dates are September 25, 2021 to October 2, 2021. The venue and location are the same, Portland, Oregon. Also, several Regional Conventions have been canceled. The Regional officers have been given an outline of what needs to be done so that we can



close our administrative year of 2019-2020 and elections for National and Regional officers via a mail-in vote. The Unit's cooperation to turn in annual reports and voting ballots, in a timely matter, will be greatly appreciated. The other challenge we have, is the membership services computer system which failed and that is being addressed, our LA FRA Website even stopped working for a few days. This is the year of change without choice, and we are going to get through this someway, somehow; with our creativity we can complete the closing of this administrative year.

NVP Jackie Scarbro and I had the opportunity to be on a conference call with the FRA BOD Midyear meeting. She was successful to get her audio working and for myself, I missed a step, but they found a way so I can speak. Having this experience Jackie and I were very excited using Zoom, our minds open up to the potential of having future conference calls with our Board of Directors with video and audio capabilities. For now, we are using audio conference calls. This technology could be a good communication tool for the Board of Directors, Regional Officers and Units to have remote meetings. Our world is changing and perhaps what we are facing now is leading us to better ways to communicate, to have members be more active and not feel separated, most of all to remind us how much we do appreciate seeing each other and doing things together.

This year we have two candidates running for the office of National Financial Secretary, their resolutions will be sent with the ballots. Normally at a National Convention, there is an "interview" that is done so that the delegates can get to know more about the candidates before voting. With the ballots being sent, we have compiled a set of questions for the candidates to answer so the Units can review. The NFS position includes the Membership, so it is important to select the right person who will do the job. Doing mail-in votes means proxy voting is prohibited, ballots submitted are to be signed by both the Unit President and Unit Secretary.

Protect yourself, wear a mask and keep a safe distance. I would like to welcome the new members of the LA FRA; congratulations to all who are celebrating a special event this August; sending prayers for healing, strength and courage for those who are facing challenges. Thank you to those that had contributed to Operation Homefront, the National President's project.

SUBJ: Election of National Officers

1. Be advised that the Fleet Reserve Association and the Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association have postponed their respective national convention (93<sup>rd</sup> and 88<sup>th</sup>) for association year 2019-2020 to 2021.

2. Due to this circumstance, voting for the subject offices will be held in accordance to the LA FRA C&BL, Article 7 – National and Regional Officers, Section 707. Voting by Mail, Sub-section 707(a).

Sub-section 707(a). In the event the FRA is unable to hold an Annual National Convention, the elections provided for in Section 610(b) shall be conducted by mail.

3. The procedure for voting is covered in Article 7, Section 707, Sub-section 707(c) and (d). *If a unit has not sent in the Unit Officer Information form it is imperative that it be sent to the NES and received prior to <u>20 August 020</u>, <i>in order for the files to be up-to-date and correct*. The Unit Officer Information form can be scanned and then e-mailed to the NES. (NES address: 2929 Bobcat Ct., Green Cove Springs, FL 32043 or aquaspacev@aol.com)

Sub-section 707(c). The National Executive Secretary promptly prepares a ballot for the several offices to be filled and forwards it to all Units for mail vote.

Sub-section 707(d). Ballots shall be enclosed in an envelope and sealed; the word "Ballot" shall be marked on the outside of the envelope; the ballots shall be received by the National Executive Secretary of the LA FRA by midnight 31 August, or suffer disqualification. Voting shall be by written ballot only and bears the signatures of the Unit President and Secretary, certifying that the ballot is the vote of the Unit.

4. The procedure for the tally is covered in Article 7, Sub-section 707(e).

Sub-section 707(e). On 1 September, the ballots shall be opened and tallied in the presence of a committee of not less than three members, non-candidates, appointed by the National President and they certify the election results to the National President.

Sub-section 707(f). A majority of the votes cast shall elect. When the vote is by mail, proxy voting is prohibited.

5. The ballots will be sent to Unit Secretaries, if there has been a change of address for the unit secretary it is imperative that the NES be advised prior to 15 July 2020. <u>Any ballot that does not bear the signature of the Unit</u> <u>President and Unit Secretary as listed on the Unit Officer Information form on file with the NES will be considered</u> <u>an invalid ballot and will not be counted.</u>

6. The number of votes a unit has to cast is listed on the Unit's 'Annual Membership Report - March 31, 2020, titled as 'Total Number of Votes at Convention.' <u>Any ballot that is received with a greater number of votes than</u> <u>the authorized number of votes will be considered as an invalid ballot and will not be counted</u>. If you are not sure of the number of votes the unit is authorized, please contact NFS Pat Suckow [lafranfs@gmail.com] to verify the number of votes.

7. When voting on the National Board of Directors' resolutions, you will be voting *Proceed*, this does not require a 'number' vote. These are the items that would normally, at convention, be handled on a 'proceed' basis.

8. In accordance to LA FRA C&BL, Article 7, Section 707, Sub-section 707(h): In the event that a majority vote is not received for any contested office, a run-off election shall be held immediately between the two candidates receiving the largest number of votes, allowing forty-five days for the return of the ballots to National Executive Secretary of the LA FRA.

9. In accordance to LA FRA C&BL, Article 7, Section 707, Sub-section 707(g): The National President informs the members of the LA FRA of the results of the election.

Official ballots have already been sent to the Units. Unit Secretary if you have not received the ballots please contact the LA FRA National Executive Secretary Vera Thomas.

Excerpts and adapted information from our history book about a previous year a convention was not held.

Margaret Drobney became National President at the 1941 convention in New York, New York. She made several official visits on her way home in San Diego, CA and prepared to visit her husband on duty in Honolulu. That is where she was on December 7, 1941, she saw what the Auxiliary was capable of under trying circumstances. The Honolulu Unit acted immediately, working under shell fire to give aid and comfort to the injured and dying and comforting the families. She and Unit members volunteered their services for the war effort and carried on in Navy tradition. The continuous 'blackouts' and curtailment of any but absolutely necessary public gatherings, made Unit meetings next to impossible, moving to afternoon meeting when feasible, but the Units carried on. Mail service and all communications with the Philippines and Guam had been discontinued. None knew how our members in those parts were existing. It was to be learned, in due time, that those of our people in the Island of the Pacific who survived the invasions, were placed in concentration camps. Our women volunteered their services for work with the American Red Cross; the Salvation Army; the American Women's Volunteer Service; Air Raid Wardens; the United Service Organization; and many other agencies.

Many of our women of the Ladies Auxiliary of the Fleet Reserve Association joined the WAVES, the WACS, the SPARS and other service organizations. The retired men and the Fleet Reservists were back once more in uniform and in most cases, once more aboard ships. These were the days of food rationing and the limitation of gasoline and other commodities. Throughout the Auxiliary organization, attendance at meeting was somewhat curtailed, but the Auxiliary carried one.
