Service dogs are such a magical and special creature. K9's for Warrior's as they train and match veterans/dogs teams. Warriors can return to their communities with a new "Leash" on life as productive citizens who make a positive difference. Roughly 90% of their service dogs come from shelters, instead of a life of abandonment they are given a new purpose. 

The following are the LA FRA Constitution & Bylaws (C&BL) resolutions that have been ratified by the FRA. Remember to change your copy of the C&BL to the ratified version listed below.

C&BL Resolutions

Section 604(d): Minutes of the convention shall be presented in a summarized format. The Jr. Past National President has the authority to use discretion regarding the documents type set and page layout when publishing the National Convention Minutes.

C&BL Article 8, Section 809(q) 4 state: Update all records, physical and electronic, address changes, email address entry and changes, dues payments, terminations, etc.

Article 8, Section 809(q)4(a) be added to state: Members' emails addresses are confidential and will be used only to provide LA FRA correspondence, distribution of the Triangle and official notification. It will not be listed on the Monthly Unit Roster nor provided or sold to a third party. The email address will remain as part of the members' profile while the membership is in good standing.

C&BL Article 8, Section 809(q) 7(d) states: Annually report to the NP and NVP a list of the Life Membership until such time as all life members are verified as deceased or unable to locate. Upon removal from the Life Member List the members name shall be included in the next National LA FRA Memorial Ceremony.

C&BL Article 9, Section 904 General Funds, Subsection 904(c) Fidelity Bond shall state: National Officers that have custody of Auxiliary funds shall be bonded under a Position Fidelity Bond. The National President, National Vice President, National Treasurer, and National Financial Secretary shall be bonded for an appropriate amount as recommended by the National Budget and Finance Committee to the NBOD. Premiums on the bond shall be paid from the funds of the Treasury.

C&BL Article 14 Unit Organization, Section 1409 Fidelity Bond *be deleted* from the LA FRA C&BL and Section 1409 the following be renumbered to continue consecutive numbering with 1410 renumbered to 1409 and 1411 renumbered to 1410, etc.

The following is the LA FRA Standing Rule (SR) resolution that has been ratified by the FRA. There are other resolutions that are waiting on ratification and they will be published after the resolutions are ratified. Remember to change your copy of the Standing Rules to the ratified version listed below.

SR-16 Fidelity Bond SR-16(a) state: The National President, National Vice President, National Financial Secretary, and National Treasurer shall be bonded under a position fidelity bond provided for by the Auxiliary. Premiums on the bond shall be paid from the funds of the Treasury.

Not acted on resolution: Article 3, Section 301(a) - Membership eligibility

The FRA requested a stop action on the change in LA FRA membership eligibility, until they can meet with their lawyers and agree on what the FRA needs to do to meet the Military Family Act of 2003. LA FRA membership eligibility meets the Military Families Act of 2003 which is the current law that affects service members' family members' ability to belong to tax exempt veteran service organizations or to an organization such as Gold Star Mothers, when the sponsoring service member is deceased. The IRS Veteran Service Manual states an auxiliary member must be related to the sponsor within 2 (two) degrees of consanguinity* and the sponsor needed to be a member of the sponsoring organization.

About the phrase "eligible at time of death", when the FRA defines the date each group became eligible to be members of the FRA, everyone joining the Auxiliary will need to have a sponsor who meets the defined appropriate eligibility date. Example: retired Navy have been eligible since 1924, retired Marines and Coast Guard were added at later dates. Active duty and women in the sea services were added at a later date and sea service veterans are the most recently added group. Continue to recruit those sea service family members, statistics show there are 2.5 family members for every veteran.

* Consanguinity ("blood relation", from Latin consanguinitas) is the characteristic of having a kinship with another person (being descended from a common ancestor).
