2021 Veterans Day Tomb of the Unknown Soldier - Arlington National Cemetery



The Tomb of the Unknown Soldier's centennial was marked on Veterans Day with a unique ceremony at Arlington National Cemetery designed to model the original internment 100 years ago. The tomb represents all American military members who lost their lives whose names remain unknown. Over two days, a flower ceremony brought long lines of people to lay flowers at the tomb. It was the first time members of the public were welcomed onto the Tomb of the Unknown Plaza in almost 100 years.

Accounts should have 2 or 3 authorized signers Checks should correspond to budgeted line item All payments require a source document, drawn voucher and paper check
