From the Desk of the VAVS Chairman

To all Auxiliary Members

- 1. Survivor Benefit /with Dic offset ended February 1, 2023. So now surviving spouses (male or female) will be receiving both SPB and DIC without offset.
- Pact Act. To see if you were in a location with Agent Orange Presumption see this website https://www.publichealth.va.gov/exposures/agentorange/locations/index.asp Pact Act has added an addition presumptive disease. Hypertension and the lab test for monoclonal gammopathy of undetermined significance (MGUS) precursor for multiple myeloma.
- 3. In most cities you can register the DD214 at your local court house for example DD214. In Virginia Beach you may register your DD214 in the Court House, Bldg. 10 3rd floor. I strongly urge each shipmate to register their DD214 in case of fire, flood, or you just can't find the DD214. You need the most current DD214 to file any claims, get a VA mortgage, VA Health care and VA Burial. The only person who may access the DD214 at the courthouse is the spouse or adult child. The Service member can specify at the time of registering the DD 214.
